C.A.S. Award 2018-2019

ECAs on Engage

This year High School and SD will be using Engage to sign up, monitor and report on all extra-curricular activities. Our aim is to improve the system, making it easier and clearer for parents, students and teachers.

Please note:

- All payments for activities must go directly to the High School office once the student has been enrolled unless otherwise stated. Please see payment deadlines above
- If payment has not been received by the payment deadline the student will be removed from the activity list and the space opened for other students.
- If a student wants to join an activity after the booking window, Admin staff in the SD and High School office can enroll them if it is available.
- Not all activities are available to all Classes. Only those available will be shown on Engage
- In High School most activities are available to sign up every term. There are a few exceptions that require sign up for a whole Semester, please check the club details carefully.
- Most activities require a minimum number of students to run. If this number is not met parents will be contacted.
- Activities run on a first come, first served basis. If the club capacity has reached maximum it will no longer be available to select.
- Details of clubs may change throughout the year due to unforeseen circumstances. These will be updated on Engage.


