Everyone working together will ensure a fun, active and exciting programme for the students.

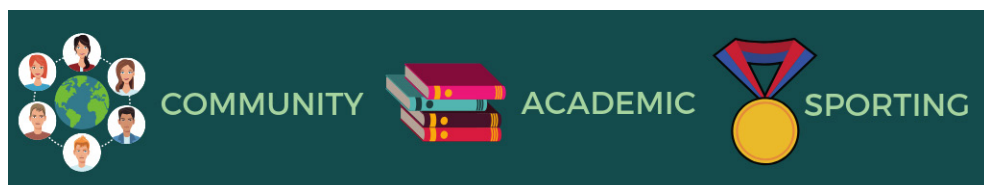

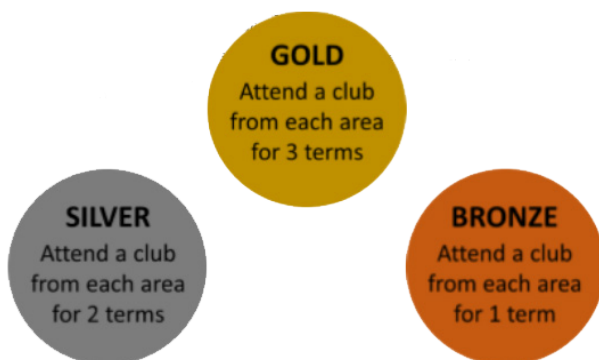
C.A.S. Award 2019-2020

The C.A.S. Award is given in recognition of students who participate in a range of Extracurricular Activities and commit fully to these throughout the year. Please note:

- Students must sign up for activities (and pay if necessary) each Term.
- Activities run for 8 weeks, some may differ slightly due to public holidays.
- Activities run on a first come, first served basis. If the activity capacity has reached maximum it will no longer be available to select.
- Not all activities are available to all Classes. Only those available will be shown on Engage.
- All activities require a minimum number of students to run. If this number is not met parents will be contacted.
- Payment must be received BEFORE the activity commences. Please see payment deadlines above.
- All payments for activities must go directly to the Primary office or HS office once the student has been enrolled unless otherwise stated.
- If payment has not been received by the payment deadline the student will be removed from the activity register and the space opened for other students.
- If a student wants to join an activity after the booking window, Admin staff in the Primary and High School office can enroll them if it is available.
- Details of activities may change throughout the year due to unforeseen circumstances. These will be updated on Engage.


