Everyone working together will ensure a fun, active and exciting programme for the students.

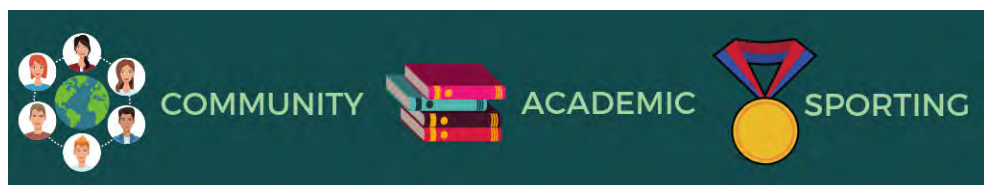

Using data in Geography helps us to spot patterns, trends and relationships between different things. Data analysis can be qualitative and/or quantitative, and may include statistical tests.

This ECA will look at different examples of secondary data and what it tells us about the topic in question and will look at collecting data ourselves (primary data) to test certain geographical theories.

This ECA will be extremely useful to iGCSE Class 10 Geography students completing their independent coursework as 40% of the final coursework marks will be awarded for demonstrating appropriate data presentation skills and a sound analysis of primary field data.



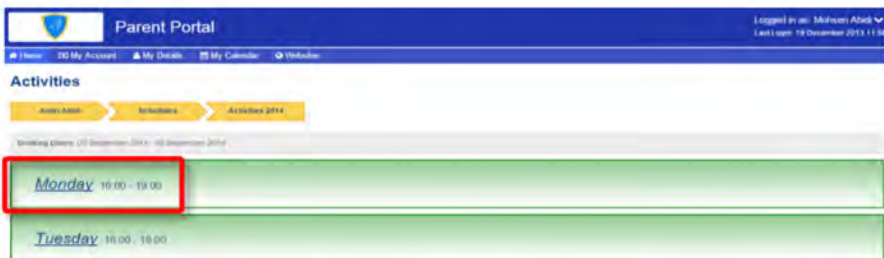
