Everyone working together will ensure a fun, active and exciting programme for the students.

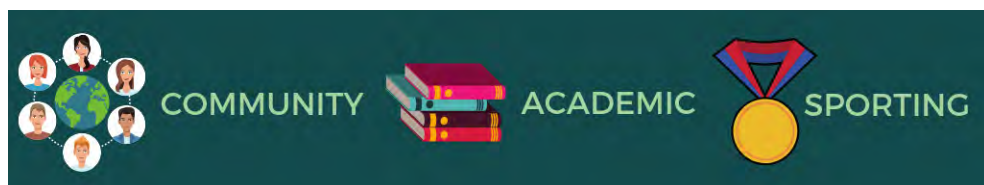

- Students must sign up for activities (and pay if necessary) each Term.

- Not all activities are available to all Classes. Only those available will be shown on Engage.
- All activities require a minimum number of students to run. If this number is not met parents will be contacted.
- ECAs being run by external providers have a cost
- If there is a cost for the ECA, please make payment directly to the provider.
- Please do not pay any money until sign-up closes and the ECA is confirmed to be going ahead (if the minimum number is not reached, the ECA will be cancelled).
- Once confirmed, Dyatmika will send an email with bank details to families requesting payment to be made to the provider before the ECA starts.
- Details of activities may change throughout the year due to unforeseen circumstances. These will be updated on Engage.C.A.S. Extracurricular Awards will be given at the end of each term for students who show excellent participation in and commitment to the Extracurricular Programme


